Terms of Reference (Annex 1)

Introduction

The Ghana Research and Industry Collaborative (GRIC), hosted by Impact Investing Ghana, is a national collaborative aimed at fostering collaboration and innovation between researchers and industry stakeholders. Comprising universities, applied research institutions, firms, government entities, and international partners, GRIC operates under a Steering Committee with three sub-committees focusing on collaboration, capacity-building and fundraising. As a catalyst for collaboration, GRIC identifies industry research needs, mobilises research outputs, supports research development, facilitates stakeholder collaboration, organises learning workshops, hosts policy dialogues, and advocates for resources to bolster research and innovation. By bridging the research-industry gap, GRIC aims to unlock Ghana's untapped potential in research and innovation for national development.

Project Overview

GRIC seeks to engage individual consultants or a team of experts to simplify academic research outputs in a short and actionable format that can be easily understood and used by industry stakeholders. The aim is to bridge the gap between research and industry by facilitating the uptake and practical application of high-quality research outputs across various industry stakeholders.

Scope of work

The individual consultant or team of experts consultancy service will encompass the following activities:

- Transform selected research outputs into industry-friendly formats, including summaries and relevant informative infographics, using the GRIC research brief template;
- The language of the research summary and infographics should be simple and easy for ordinary users who are not scientists or familiar with scientific terminology to understand;
- Share the summarised research with the author(s) for input and sign-off;
- Identify keywords to be linked/associated as hashtags to the simplified research outputs on GRIC platform. The keywords should be simple and

everyday-words that the user would be using to search on the GRIC platform;
and

- Participate in a learning call to share insights regarding the research summaries

Working tool:

The main working tool for collaboration will be Google Documents, facilitating efficient teamwork, tracking of edits, and seamless sharing of information.

Deliverables

The consultancy service will deliver the following outputs:

- Translate one or more research output into industry-friendly format (max 2 page) including infographics where relevant and to be shared via the GRIC platform <https://gricghana.org> (Note: The goal is to have 60 simplified research outputs in total);
- Generate list of keywords attached/associated to the simplified research output(s);
- Secure input and sign-off on the research summaries from the respective author(s);
- Provide feedback on the research summaries

Duration and Timeline

The duration for the contract is: May 13, 2024 – July 30, 2024 with the following timelines:

- Notice of Application – April 29, 2024.
- Application Deadline – May 9, 2024
- Selection Process and announcement- May 13, 2024
- Kick-off Meeting with Project Management Team – May 14, 2024

Qualification and expertise

The consultancy service provider should demonstrate:

- Proven experience in the relevant research thematic area with requisite qualifications
- Expertise in translating complex research findings into practical insights for industry stakeholders (provide previous works in simple English written for a non-academic audience)

- Familiarity with various industry sectors and an understanding of their unique challenges and opportunities
- Excellent communication, attention to detail and accuracy in work
- Imagination and good visual sense
- Proficiency in IT skills, including word processing

Budget for the project: \$40 (inclusive of withholding tax) per simplified research output
